FINANCING

Participating business owners will have access to discuss financing needs directly with The PrivateBank to secure a business loan or line of credit. Training application is required.

Eligibility: The CIRCLE Program was created to support start-up or early stage small businesses in need of working capital and operating in Hyde Park, Kenwood, Oakland, Washington Park and/or Woodlawn.

Financing Amounts: The PrivateBank offers lines of credit and term loans with a minimum required loan of \$1,000 and up to \$10,000 for start-up and up to \$25,000 for early-stage businesses. We'll work with you to determine the right loan size for your business needs.

Cost: No fees or prepayment penalties. All financing arrangements require interest payments.
